1. **MEETING CALLED TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order by Commissioner Cossey at 5:00 PM.

2. **INVOCATION AND PLEDGE**

Commissioner Nettles delivered the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

3. **DISCUSSION CONCERNING LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATION AMENDMENTS RELATED TO MINING**

Attorney Wade informed the Board that there is no action to be taken, but that this is a presentation from the North Florida Regional Planning Council to update the Board about the text amendments relating to the LDR amendments.

Sondra Joseph presented updates regarding the proposed LDR to the Board of County Commissioners. Ms. Joseph stated that mining applicants have to submit all materials from local workshops and also provide notice to all residents at least ten days before the workshop. The applicants must provide a general concept plan for the proposed mine, as well as access ways and general rights of way. The applicant must also present their plans to both the Board of Planning and Zoning as well as the Board of County Commissioners. Ms. Joseph stated that an applicant will also have to pay for annual inspection of the operation.


