MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

Chair Cossey called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm. Commissioner Tallman offered the invocation and led Pledge of Allegiance.

PRESENTATION OF PROPOSED MILLAGE

Chair Cossey announced the proposed 10.000 millage rate, rolled-back rate of 9.7748 and called for public comments. Hearing no request for public comments, she closed the floor to public comments and called for Board action. Commissioner Tallman moved to accept the proposed rate of 10.000 mils, and Commissioner Cannon seconded the motion. It passed unanimously.

PRESENTATION OF BUDGET

Chair Cossey turned the floor over to Clerk Rhoades for presentation of the budget. Clerk Rhoades walked the Board through the budget, indicating major changes from the previous year, especially highlighting the level of uncertainty at the current time given the Coronavirus pandemic and resulting economic shutdown, and the CARES Act funding.

Chair Cossey called for public comments, and hearing non, she closed the floor to public comments.

Commissioner Dobbs moved, and Commissioner Cannon seconded, to adopt the tentative budget. All commissioners voted for the motion.

With no further business, Chair Cossey adjourned the meeting.
